### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read Luke 10:1-24. We know little about the 70 that Jesus sent. What do you think qualified them to be sent out by Jesus? What did he send them to do? Do you see yourself as one sent by Jesus?
2. The Pharisees labeled Jesus a “friend of sinners.” It wasn’t his preaching to them that earned him this title, but rather the fact that he extended extravagant grace to them, by eating with them. Where have you received Jesus’ extravagant grace? Do you live with awareness of all that you’ve received? How does that affect your interactions with others?
3. “There was a moment I agreed with God’s version of the Gospel versus my version of the Gospel.” In the prison, Carlos made a choice to speak the grace of God to someone he personally would struggle to forgive. How do you respond to this story?
4. Theologian Frederick Buechner said, “The place God calls you is the place where your deep gladness and the world’s deep hunger meet.” What causes or needs of the world keep you up at night? What do you love to do? What are you good at? Do you see God as a cynical father, tolerating your hopes and spiritual dreams? Do you believe that he is one who “rejoices” in who you are? Do you dare to believe that Jesus says yes to you?
